

Cannon Mountain Season Pass Rules/Notes 2020-2021

1. NEW HAMPSHIRE RESIDENT DISCOUNT (RSA 227:14): Passes must be purchased on or before December 14, 2020 to qualify for the current New Hampshire resident rate. Applications must be accompanied by proof of New Hampshire residency, such as a state-issued driver's license or state-issued non-driver's photo ID card. Ownership of property and/or New Hampshire taxpayer status is not a qualifier for New Hampshire residency.

2. LOST/STOLEN/FORGOTTEN SEASON PASS POLICY: Possession of a season pass is the passholder's responsibility. If a pass is lost, stolen, or forgotten, the following policy will be in place: Upon the first day or occurrence, a complimentary day pass may be issued. Upon the second day or occurrence, a \$5 day pass may be purchased. Upon the third day or occurrence, a \$10 day pass may be purchased. Upon the fourth day or occurrence, a mandatory \$25 season pass replacement fee will be charged (minus any fees you have already paid).

3. DATE FOR DETERMINING PASS AGE CATEGORIES: Your pass category is determined by whatever your age is or will be on December 14, 2020*. Senior Pass, ages 65+; Adult Pass, ages 30-64; NEW Young Adult Pass ages 18-29 Teen Pass: ages 13-17; Junior Pass, ages 6 - 12; Child Pass, ages 5 & under. Proof of ages is required at pickup.

5. NH SENIOR MIDWEEK PASS (RSA 218:5c): A "NH Senior" is considered to be anyone who is a New Hampshire resident who is 65 years or older on the date of purchase. NH Seniors are eligible for a free lift ticket, Monday - Friday. Tickets may be picked up at Guest Services. If a season pass is preferred, a \$39 processing fee applies. A valid New Hampshire ID is required. Proof of residency is required, such as a state-issued driver's license or state-issued non-driver's photo ID card. Ownership of property and/or New Hampshire taxpayer status is not a qualifier for New Hampshire residency.

6. BOLD & BEAUTIFUL PASS: Valid Monday thru Friday non-holiday at Bretton Woods and Cannon, PLUS: Daily from opening day through Dec 11, 2020; Daily from Mar 15, 2021 through closing day. BLACKOUTS: Dec 25, 2020-January 1, 2021, Jan 18, 2021 & Feb 15-19, 2021.

7. 2020 - 2021 PASS PICKUP: Passes will not be issued until Fall 2020 unless you qualify as a new passholder. Spring Bonus Passes for new passholders may be issued at the time of purchase during the 2019-2020 season. New passholders will need to pick up a new 20-21 pass in the Fall 2020.

8. REFUNDS: Please see our Refunds/Credit Policy for details.

9. SUMMER TRAM BENEFIT: Summer Tram Benefit for Summer 2021 will be evaluated this winter and may not be offered due to COVID-19. Check with Guest Services.

10. AERIAL TRAMWAY OPERATING SCHEDULE for 2020-2021 *UPDATED 10-1-2020: The Aerial Tramway is not expected to run for at least the first half of the 20-21 season and the closure could be extended beyond that due to COVID-19 Restrictions. My initials indicate that I have read and understand the terms and conditions set forth on both sides of this form.

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
